Elementary Program

Math

Kindergarten students will learn to identify likeness and differences between pairs of items. First graders are comparing and ordering whole numbers up to 100. Second grade students are beginning the foundation of place value. Third and Fourth grade students are continuing to review the basics of multiple digit addition and subtraction and 2 digit multiplication facts.

Phonics

The Kinder students will began short vowel sounds and review all letter sounds.

The elementary students will cover capitalization rules and review four types of sentences.
