Bible study is a required part of each student's curriculum and students are required to attend Chapel services. As a part of its basic philosophy of education, CA also recognizes that the home is primarily responsible for the development of Christian character, and that the school is responsible for building on this foundation.				
In order to build on this foundation, CA must, therefore, provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people who are not yet mature Christians. We believe in a Standard of Conduct based upon Biblical principles of Christian living.				
The school, therefore, expects each student to maintain Christian standards of courtesy, kindness, morality, and honesty. The school further requires each student to refrain from profanity, indecent language, gambling, cheating, stealing, and use of any type of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, and pornographic materials, and from participation in unlawful, violent, or destructive acts both within and outside the school environment.				
Students are expected to abide by these standards throughout their enrollment at Cornerstone Academy. This includes both in-school and out-of-school activities. Students found to be out of harmony with the CA Christian principles may be withdrawn from CA whenever the general welfare of the student body demands it, at the sole discretion of the superintendent. It should be understood that this is a joint agreement between the school, the parent, and the student. Both the school and the parent must enforce these standards while the student is associated with CA.
